1. Title of the Paper

• Font: Times New Roman, Bold, 14 pt

• Alignment: Centered

• Format: Title Case (Capitalize Major Words)

2. Author(s) Details

• Name(s) of Author(s)

• **Affiliation(s)** (Institution, Department)

• Email Address(es)

• Corresponding Author: Indicate with an asterisk (*)

• Font: Times New Roman, 12 pt, Centered

3. Keywords

• Provide 3–5 keywords relevant to the paper.

• Font: Times New Roman, 12 pt, Italic

• Alignment: Left

4. Extended Abstract

Maximum Word Count: 1,000 words (excluding title, author details, keywords, and

references)

Font: Times New Roman, 12 pt

Spacing: 1.5 line spacing

Alignment: Justified

Margins: 1 inch on all sides

The extended abstract should include the following clearly labeled sections:

a. Introduction / Background

Brief context and rationale for the study.

b. Objectives / Research Questions

Clearly state the aims and/or research questions.





c. Methodology

Outline the research design, sampling, data collection, and analysis methods.

d. Results / Expected Results

Present key findings or expected outcomes.

e. Discussion and Conclusion

Discuss the significance of the findings and their implications.

5. References

- Use **APA 7th Edition** referencing style.
- Include only key references cited in the abstract (maximum 5 references).
- Font: Times New Roman, 12 pt, single line spacing.

6. Formatting and Submission Guidelines

- File Format: MS Word (.doc/.docx)
- File Name: SERSA2025 [First Author Last Name] [Short Title].docx
- **Submission:** [Provide email address or online submission link]
- **Deadline for Submission:** [Insert Date]

7. Additional Notes

- All submissions will undergo a double-blind peer review by the symposium review panel.
- Accepted abstracts must be presented at the Symposium by at least one of the authors.
- Accepted extended abstracts will be published in the SERSA Conference Proceedings.
- Authors of selected papers will be invited to submit full papers for possible publication in the Journal of Educational Research in South Asia (JERSA).
